Mary Hoernecke is the Women's Masters winner with five fish and 87 points while Becky Oestreich caught two fish for 27 points to win the Women's Division. Tammie Lester was the only other woman to register a fish. She caught a 36-incher. Ben Wilary is the winner of the Junior Division with seven fish and 63 points. Vote for Mark Carlson's musky

Let's put a musky on top of the fishing world. Mark Carlson's world-record IGFA musky is up for catch of the year for 2014. He was in second place the last time I checked behind some tuna. Do you really want something you eat out of a can to beat a musky? You can vote daily in February. Just search "IGFA contest", click it, go to Mark's picture, click. You'll have to register as a member with your email. They will send you a verification link which you click, then sign in, then vote. Takes about 3 minutes. Then just sign in daily and vote! **Update:** The tuna looks like it is unbeatable, but let's make sure Mark hangs on to second place. He was only about 40 votes ahead of a marlin when I put the finishing touches on this newsletter. As an added incentive, you could win a Yeti cooler, the kind Jim Saric promotes on The Musky Hunter television show. When you vote, your name is automatically entered in the contest for four Yeti products (big cooler, small cooler hopper, mug). The more you vote, the more chances you have to win.
