There were 18 guys on the trip that ended last week and 60 muskies, a bunch of northern pike and a few smallmouth bass and walleyes were landed. Dave Jack and Jerry Oestreich each caught eight muskies to lead the group. Jerry and Stu Adrian (four fish) were the top team. On the other end of the scale, Jeff Blanck and Brian Hansas had zero muskies when the outing ended. Jeff and Brian didn't arrive in camp until July 14 and were staying until July 21. Brian caught a 48 and a 45 after the rest of us left. Jeff got on the board with a 39 and a 31.5. Lots of fish were seen, but it was hard to get them to commit. A couple of storms chased us off the water early. We had a fish fry Wednesday and the group came in at 3 p.m. to eat. Good thing. By the time we were done a big storm hit, keeping us off the water the rest of the day. We'll tell fish stories at Thursday's meeting. Please attend and join (or re-live) the fun.
