The ciscos/tullibees were not on top of the reef for the

Prior attendees will get first shot at cabin vacancies and then it will be on a first-come, first-serve basis until we fill our allotment of cabins. Last year Tim Scruggs caught the biggest fish of the week with a 52.5. Steve Ruhmann caught a 51.5 on the same day at the same time. Other big fish were Leo Hauser's 51 and Jerry Oestreich's 51. You may remember that Leo was last year's winner of the prestigious Skunk Award. Another biggie was Jack Pertz's 49.5. Fishing was a little tougher last year due to 4-foot high water as well as high winds. Regardless LOTW is putting out a large number of 45-50+ inch fish so if you are looking to possibly get a new personal best, this is the lake that can do it.
